



EUROPEAN CIRCUIT 2007

Notice of Race amended 23.04.2007

1. Organizing Authority

- 1.1 The Organizing Authority will be the Farr 40 European Fleet in conjunction with the hosting Yacht Club of each Event of the Series.
- 1.2 The Headquarters will be the Headquarters of the Farr 40 European Fleet.

2. Events Calendar

16 – 19 May	Capri	1st Event
6 – 9 June	Porto Cervo	2nd Event (valid as European Championship)
5 – 8 July	Hanko	3rd Event
12 – 14 July	Skagen	4th Event
17 – 19 August	Neustadt	5th Event

3. Eligibility

- 3.1 To qualify as an official competitor of the European Circuit the following requirements shall be met:
- Fulfil the requirements of the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions of each Event of the Series;
 - Current membership of the Farr 40 European Fleet.

4. Rules

- 4.1 The following rules shall govern the Series:
- a) the Racing Rules of sailing (RRS), 2005-2008;
 - b) the Farr 40 Class Rules;
 - c) this Notice of Race and the Notice of race of each Event of the Series;
 - d) the Sailing Instructions of each Event of the Series and any amendments thereto;

5. Language

- 5.1 English shall be the official language used in the Farr 40 European Circuit

6. Scoring

- 6.1 The Farr 40 European Circuit 2007 will be sailed in a SERIES of 5 regattas. A total of 47 races are scheduled. There will be a discard of 9 races regardless of the number of races sailed finally.
- 6.2 The low point system as described in RRS A4.1 will apply.
- 6.3 RRS A4.2 will not apply. RRS A9 will be modified as follows: For a series that is held over a period of time longer than a regatta, a boat that entered the regatta and came to the starting area but did not start, did not finish, retired after finishing or was disqualified shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats entered the regatta. A boat penalized under rule 30.2 or 44.3 shall be scored points as provided in rule 44.3(c). A boat that did not come to the starting area shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats entered in the series.
