Farr 40 One Design – The Boat

The incredible success and popularity of the MUMM 30 and COREL 45 have led to a need for an in between sized boat and hence the FARR 40 One Design was conceived. Using the same tried and tested configuration of simple carbon fiber swept spreader rig, no running backstays, non overlapping jibs and high stability keel, the FARR 40 One Design provides those seeking the excitement and performance exhibited by the MUMM 30 and Corel 45 in a mid sized boat. Also compatible with the IMS Rule, the FARR 40 One Design has proven to be a highly versatile boat that can be competitively raced under the IMS, CHS and PHRF handicapping systems. The pure simplicity and high performance characteristics make this a very popular boat.

Farr 40 Class Association

Any one design needs a strong Class Association to promote its interests and to protect its One Design. The Farr 40 Class Association ensures that the class is run according to the consensus of the owner's wishes and that there is a cost effective, fun racing circuit.

The Farr 40 Class Association celebrates its tenth anniversary this year and is proud to have active fleets competing in Australia, Europe, Great Britain and the USA. In total, over 100 Farr 40s are registered with the class, and compete at regional, national and international level, with the racing season culminating in the annual Rolex Farr 40 World Championship (www.farr40.kdy.dk). With 15 new-builds ordered in the past year alone, and hull number 130 on order, the Class looks set to go from strength to strength.

The owner-driver rule makes for competitive racing among the Farr 40s but owners are also encouraged to actively participate in the Class Association to help determine future developments and to form new local fleets. The Class is in fact governed by an Executive Committee of owners from all the active racing regions in conjunction with a Management Group consisting of representatives from Staggs Yachts and Farr Yacht Design. The activities of the European Fleet are coordinated and managed by the Farr 40 European Fleet inside the Farr 40 Class Association.

The European fleet is internationally very active, as demonstrated by the strong turn-out at the 2007 Miami Acura Grand Prix where, 10 of 16 boats were European Fleet members. The Miami event proved to be a testing ground for the new Masthead Spinnaker rule which saw owners and crews getting to grips with the new sails: The new Masthead Spinnaker rule is designed to inject yet more innovation into this thriving and dynamic class. The European fleet is grateful to Rolex, main sponsor of the Class and Title sponsor of the European Championship, the Rolex Capri Sailing Week, the Rolex Baltic Week and the Farr 40 World Championship 2007, for its ongoing support.
