Hi everyone -

I'm really excited to be part of the team and look forward to meeting many of you soon! We have a terrific schedule planned for Europe this summer, leading up to the Rolex Farr 40 Worlds in Copenhagen August 29 -September 1. In order keep the momentum going, we'd like your input on scheduling events later this year and into 2008.

The 2008 Rolex Farr 40 pre-Worlds and World Championship are scheduled for April 11- 12 and 16 - 19, 2008 respectively, in Miami Beach, Florida. One of the big benefits of these dates is the existence of quality winter events in Florida leading up to ours. The class already expects to compete in Key West Race Week January 21-25 and Acura Miami Race Week March 6-9.

At the owners meeting in Miami Beach on March 8, there was interest in adding an additional event to the winter schedule. The proposed schedule of an additional event is as follows:

Farr 40 Winter Series #1 - Miami Beach, Florida, USA

November 27 -28, 2007            Match Racing

November 30 - December 2    Fleet Racing
