Notice of Race

1. Organizing Authority

- 1.1 The Organizing Authority will be the Farr 40 European Fleet in conjunction with the hosting Yacht Club of each Event of the Series.
- 1.2 The Headquarters will be the Headquarters of the Farr 40 European Fleet.

2. Events

- 2.1 The European Circuit 2008 has a Med and a North part. Each competitor shall enter one of the two parts before the first race. He may race up to two regattas in the respectively other part.
- 2.2 Events Calendar (racing days)

12 – 14 June	Porto Cervo	2nd Event Circuit Med
26 – 29 June	Kiel	2nd Event Circuit North
3 – 6 July	Le Lavandou	3rd Event Circuit Med
24 – 27 July	Copenhagen	3rd Event Circuit North
26 – 31 August	Travemuende	4th and final event Circuit North (valid also as European Championship)
19 – 21 Sept.	Cala Galera	4th and final event Circuit Med

3. Eligibility

- 3.1 To qualify as an official competitor of one of the European Circuits the following requirements shall be met:
 - Fulfil the requirements of this Notice of Race and the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions of each Event of the Series;
 - Current membership of the Farr 40 European Fleet and valid entry for one of the both European Circuits.

4. Rules

- 4.1 The following rules shall govern the Series:
 - a) the Racing Rules of sailing (RRS), 2005-2008;
 - b) the Farr 40 Class Rules;
 - c) this Notice of Race and the Notice of race of each Event of the Series;
 - d) the Sailing Instructions of each Event of the Series and any amendments thereto except that neither the NOR or SIs shall alter any class rules ;

5. Language

- 5.1 English shall be the official language used in the Farr 40 European Circuits.

6. Scoring

- 6.1 Each Farr 40 European Circuit 2008 will be sailed in a series of 4 regattas. 35 races in each Circuit will be scored.
- 6.2 The low point system as described in RRS A4.1 will apply.
- 6.3 RRS A4.2 will not apply. RRS A9 will be modified as follows: For a series that is held over a period of time longer than a regatta, a boat that entered the regatta and came to the starting area but did not start, did not finish, retired after finishing or was disqualified shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats entered the regatta. A boat penalized under rule 30.2 or 44.3 shall be scored points as provided in rule 44.3(c). A boat that did not come to the starting area shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats entered in the series.
