



FARR 40 EUROPEAN FLEET CIRCUIT 2009

Notice of Race

1. Organizing Authority

- 1.1 The Organizing Authority will be the Farr 40 European Fleet in conjunction with the hosting Yacht Club of each Event of the Series.
- 1.2 The Headquarters will be the Headquarters of the Farr 40 European Fleet.

2. Events Calendar (racing days)

24 – 26 April	Farr 40 Regatta Porto Rotondo	1 st Event
20 – 23 May	Rolex Capri Sailing Week	2 nd Event
20 – 21 June	Farr 40 Audi Invitational Porto Cervo	3 rd Event
27 July – 01 August	European Championship Cagliari	4 th Event

3. Eligibility

- 3.1 To qualify as an official competitor of one of the European Circuits the following requirements shall be met:
 - Fulfil the requirements of this Notice of Race and the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions of each Event of the Series;
 - Current membership of the Farr 40 European Fleet.

4. Rules

- 4.1 The following rules shall govern the Series:
 - a) the Racing Rules of sailing (RRS), 2009-2012;
 - b) the Farr 40 Class Rules;
 - c) this Notice of Race and the Notice of race of each Event of the Series;
 - d) the Sailing Instructions of each Event of the Series and any amendments thereto;

5. Language

- 5.1 English shall be the official language used in the Farr 40 European Circuits.

6. Scoring

- 6.1 The Farr 40 European Circuit 2009 will be sailed in a Series of 4 Events. A total of 33 races are scheduled. There will be a discard of 8 races.
- 6.2 The low point system as described in low point Appendix A4 will apply.
- 6.3 RRS A4.2 will not apply. RRS A9 will be modified as follows: For a series that is held over a period of time longer than a regatta, a boat *that entered the regatta and* came to the starting area but did not start, did not finish, retired after finishing or was disqualified shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats entered the regatta. *A boat penalized under rule 30.2 or 44.3 shall be scored points as provided in rule 44.3(c).* A boat that did not come to the starting area shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats entered in the series.
